 - 10 minute presentation with a 5 minute question period
- Numerical Expertise
 - Very little numerical expertise will be required for this category, as it will mainly be testing qualitative aspects to business law.
- Creative Ability
 - There will be limited marketing or creative skills needed, as you will not be pitching a brand new idea to a company. You will need to know more on the required steps when a legal issue arises.
- Quick Thinking Skills
 - Like all DECA U cases, given the time constraint, Business Law will include extensive quick thinking skills in order to think convey your ideas and message.
